


Route 6 Corridor Study Now Underway




Welcome to the Route 6 Corridor Study!

The City of Bristol is conducting a Route 6 Corridor Study to guide future decisions about this area of Bristol: how land should be developed, how the corridor should look, and how the Route 6 roadway should function. The purpose of this study is to develop a long-term plan for how best to encourage reinvestment in the corridor and at the same time encourage future development to be of a shape and form everyone in Bristol desires.

Study Area

The area being studied extends through Bristol from the Farmington town line to the Plymouth town line, along Farmington Avenue, North Street, and Terryville Avenue.

Attend the Community Workshop


