On 05-10-19 at 0638hrs the Bristol Police Department received several reports of a motor vehicle crash on Farmington Avenue. Bristol Police Department and Fire Department members as well as Bristol Hospital EMS responded to the scene.

Initial investigation reveals that a red Toyota Tacoma was traveling east in the area of 1033 Farmington Avenue. The Toyota sideswiped a utility pole. Wires were downed as a result of the collision with the utility pole (BPD case #19-15963).

The Toyota continued east on Farmington Avenue and sideswiped a gray Buick Rendezvous in the area of Shop Rite Plaza. The Toyota then drove off the roadway and came to rest in the parking lot of the Wendy's Restaurant.

The female operator of the Buick was extricated from the vehicle by Bristol Fire Department. She was transported to an area hospital for care.

The male operator of the Toyota was transported to an area hospital for care.

Utility companies responded to the area to repair damage.
