There will be a Public Hearing of the Bristol City Council to be held on *Thursday, June 24, 2010 immediately following the special City Council meeting scheduled for 5:30 p.m.* in the City Hall Council Chambers, 111 North Main Street, Bristol, Connecticut. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public input regarding the Draft Report of the Charter Revision Commission's recommendations of the following:

AGENDA

1. Sec. 12 and Sec. 8(a) - Changes in the terms of the mayor, treasurer, city council, board of assessment appeals, registrars of voters and constables to four years.
2. Sec. 17 - To remove the position of assistant town clerk from the charter and make technical changes, including gender neutral references.
3. Sec. 15(a) and Sec. 18 - Change the deputy treasurer to a permanent position not subject to reappointment and make changes reflecting gender neutral references.
4. Sec. 16 - Change in the duties of the mayor by requiring annual performance evaluations for city department heads and changes reflecting gender neutral references.
5. Sec. 5 - To eliminate references to "precincts" in city council voting districts.
6. Sec. 8(a), Sec. 8(d), Sec. 9, Sec. 10, Sec. 12, Sec. 27(f), Sec. 37(f), Sec. 40, Sec. 45, and Sec. 53(k) - Technical changes regarding outdated language, procedures no longer required and gender neutral references.
