1. EXECUTIVE SESSION TO DISCUSS THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRISTOL AND LOCAL #1338.

On motion of Council Member Matthews and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To convene into Executive Session to discuss the tentative agreement between the City of Bristol and Local #1338.

Present to discuss the tentative agreement between the City of Bristol and Local #1338: Mayor Ward; Council Members Block, Cockayne, Matthews, McCauley and Mills; Corp. Counsel Krawiecki; Asst. Corp. Counsel Lacey; Personnel Director Ferguson.

Discussion was held. No votes were taken.

At 5:18 p.m., on motion of Council Member Block and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To reconvene into Public Session.

2. LABOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRISTOL AND LOCAL #1338 OF COUNCIL #4 AFSCME, AFL-CIO EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2012, APPROVED.

Council Member Cockayne stated he would rather have seen a one year contract with a no-layoff guarantee.

Council Member Mills noted he would not support the Agreement since it was for a period of two years, rather than one year.

Mayor Ward thanked the Local #1338 negotiating team on the Agreement.

On motion of Council Member McCauley and seconded, it was voted: To approve the labor agreement between the City of Bristol and Local #1338 of Council #4, AFSCME, AFL-CIO for a two year contract effective July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012.

(Council Members Cockayne and Mills voted "No").
