### YOUTH SERVICE RECOGNITION DAY

The City of Bristol will be celebrating the 20<sup>th</sup> annual **Youth Service Recognition Day** on **May 8, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. at the City Council Meeting**. The Mayor and The Bristol Youth Commission will be hosting a ceremony to proudly recognize youth who have given *exceptional volunteer service* to their community. The Bristol Youth Commission is accepting nominations of Bristol youth and youth groups who have made a meaningful contribution to their school, a service agency, and the community.

**PURPOSE:** To recognize and encourage the many positive contributions that young people are making to help their neighbors and communities.

**GOAL:** To tap into the energy, enthusiasm, and creativity of young people and establish an ongoing system of outstanding volunteer service to their neighbors and community for the next generation.

Please take the time to read the criteria to make your nomination. It is important that the form is filled out completely. **This is an award of distinction; the contributions of the youth or group must be demonstrated by a clear and quantifiable description of the actions undertaken by the nominee, who benefited and how.**

**CATEGORIES:** *Individual Youth Nomination* – youth who have demonstrated *outstanding* volunteer efforts to help others through the use of his/her own thoughtfulness, energy, special talents, skills or personal abilities.

*Youth Group Nomination* – groups whose full membership, collectively and without compensation, have made significant and meaningful contributions that can be quantified by the number of activities and hours served, and qualified by the effect on the people served. One *outstanding* group in each of the three age categories will be selected by the Youth Commission. See CRITERION.

#### CRITERION:

**Hours that have been performed for credit or mandatory service projects will not be counted.**

To be considered, the volunteer service needs to be performed in two of the following three areas:  
a) school, b) non-profit organization or service club, and c) community, neighborhood, or neighbor.

**The number of volunteer hours from March 1, 2011 to February 29, 2012 needs to be quantified. The Commission is looking for a minimum of number of hours by school age grouping: elementary school – 25 – 50 hrs; middle school – 50 - 75 hrs; high school – 75 - 100 hrs. Please carefully document all hours.**

EXAMPLES OF SPECIAL CONTRIBUTIONS: Special contributions should be those which help to address some of the major problems facing cities today. The following are examples of services that may be taken into consideration in your selection process.

#### SCHOOL SERVICE

- Organizing or leading a SADD group or substance abuse prevention activity
- Fund raising for a charity or school service project
- Serving as a mentor or host to a new student

#### AGENCY/ORGANIZATION

- Creating and donating art work for a charity event
- Leading a scouting can/bottle drive to benefit a charity
- Performing in charity events
- Volunteering at a hospital or with a Red Cross Chapter
- Caring for sheltered animals or protecting wildlife through a nature center

#### COMMUNITY/NEIGHBOR

- Reaching out to support and advocate for a troubled peer or peer group
- Helping an elderly or physically challenged neighbor
- Participating in a neighborhood crime watch or beautification project
- Researching, writing and publishing a social consciousness raising article
- Participating in environmental protection projects

As the selection process is difficult, especially with group nominations, it is important to note that the selections will be made based on *exceptional volunteer service, above and beyond the call of duty*. Please include a summary highlighting his/her special qualities, talents, skills and abilities, in addition to the contributions the youth has made to his/her community.

Nomination forms for both an individual Youth and Youth Group are enclosed. **Your nominations should be submitted to the Bristol Youth Services' office no later than 11:00 a.m. on April 2, 2012.**

THE RECOGNITION EVENT: The selected youth and his/her family will be invited to attend a recognition ceremony sponsored by the City of Bristol on **May 8, 2012 at the City Council Meeting at 7:00 p.m.** At that time, each youth will be presented with a Proclamation by the Mayor recognizing his/her contributions.

The information you provide about the youth will be published in a program booklet. Please verify the correct spelling of name(s); some families may want to hold on to the booklet as a keepsake. Nominators are welcome and encouraged to attend the event on **May 8, 2012** at 7:00 p.m. at the Bristol City Hall Council Chambers.

The youth who have been selected to receive the awards will be announced to the press on the day of the presentation of the awards.
