

TRANSFER STATION REGULATIONS

- Stop -Describe Waste to Scale Attendant
- Follow Attendant's Directions
- Go straight past scale -follow driveway
- Speed limit 5 mph on all property
- Back up to unload area -no parallel parking
- Keep children and pets in vehicle at all times
- Turn vehicle off when stopped -remove keys
- No scavenging
- No climbing on barricades
- All waste must be separated -do not mix
- Paper leaf bags ok -"unbag" all plastic-bagged yard waste
- Move vehicle when unloaded
- No loitering

Key: Blue = Recyclable Materials

Clothing in plastic bags -all clean clothing plus shoes, belts, curtains, sheets, blankets, towels, etc.

Fluorescent light bulbs -standard 4 foot bulbs plus U-bulbs. No bulbs from businesses.

Antifreeze -clean, as drained from motor vehicle. No rinse water or oil.

Motor Oil -clean, as drained from motor vehicle. No solvents or antifreeze. No bleach containers to hold oil. Use another clean container.

Motor vehicle batteries -Standard lead acid batteries. No chemical batteries or non-lead batteries.

Mixed paper -phone books, soft cover books, office paper, computer paper, brown or gray paperboard, junk mail, brown paper packaging, egg cartons. No waxed or plastic items. No hard cover books.

Tires - to 16 inches. Limit of 4 tires. No businesses.

Newspaper/magazines - Loose or in brown paper bags. Remove tape or banding.

Food/beverage containers - clean glass or metal containers. Plastic #1 PET to #7 HOPE containers, & paper milk/juice cartons, flattened, caps removed.

Corrugated cardboard - clean, flattened, none waxed.

Red = MSW or Burnable Waste

All burnable waste. No chemicals. No items longer or wider than 4 feet. No shingles or sheetrock. Disposal tickets required from businesses.

Yellow = Bulky Waste (Shingles, Sheet Rock, Ceramics)

Disposal tickets required. Purchase at DPW City Hall or at Transfer Station on Saturdays.

Remove any wood.

White = White Goods (Appliances and Scrap Metals)

None from businesses or condos/apartments with more than 5 units.

Poles must be cut to 4 feet.

Motors must have all fluids removed.

Drums or cans must be clean and dry.

All pressurized tanks must have valves removed.

Green = Yard Waste (Leaves, Grass, Brush, Wood Chips)

Disposal tickets required from businesses.

Leaves/grass in paper bags can be left as-is. All others must be emptied. No dirt, sod, sand, rocks, or other debris.

Brush must be cut to 4 feet long, 6 inch diameter maximum.

Other

The City of Bristol will accept dirt, rocks, sand, cement, brick, and other clean fill at its discretion. Check with scale attendant.
