## Rent Relief Requirements for the Elderly and Totally Disabled

1. File between May 15, 2008 and September 15, 2008.
2. Driver's license or birth certificate showing that you or your spouse must have been at least 65 years of age as of December 31, 2007.
3. If you are not 65, you must be over 18 and social security disabled. You must submit a recent **TPQY** printout from social security indicating that you are a disabled individual and the date which the disability began.

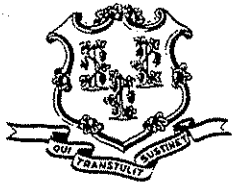
4. Maximum income:	Single	\$29,800
	Married	\$36,500

5. Proof of all 2007 income:
  - Pension
  - Bank Interest
  - Social Security (Including Medicare)
  - Any other income from 2007

Qualifying income is the **adjusted gross income** from your tax return, **plus any other income.**

6. In order for us to process your claim, a copy of your **SSA 1099 Form** must accompany your application.
7. If you file a 2007 Federal Income Tax Return, you **must** submit a copy.
8. **All rent and utility receipts from 2007.**  
Utilities include:

- Electric
- Gas
- Oil
- Water
- Heat
