The City of Bristol, Connecticut is seeking bids for the replacement of existing PLC based control system and SCADA system with new PLC controls and SCADA systems and instrumentation, and other work necessary to complete the project. A **mandatory** bidder's conference will be held on Thursday December 2, 2010 at 2:00pm at the project site. Vendors not in attendance will not be considered for award.

Bids will be accepted until **Thursday, December 9, 2010 at 3:00 pm**, at which time bids will be opened and read. Bids received after the opening date and time will not be considered for award. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bid, to reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid that in its judgment is in its best interest.

Each bid shall be in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Bristol Purchasing Department, identified as "Bid 2C11-049 Improvements to Broad Street Pumping Station SCADA and Control Upgrades" accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the bidders base bid amount, in the form of a Bid Bond made payable to the City of Bristol.

The awarded contractor will be required to secure a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract award, provided by a surety licensed to do business in the State of Connecticut. The requirements for prevailing wage rates as outlined in Connecticut General Statutes 31-53 are to apply to the resultant contract award.
