The City of Bristol is seeking bids for mechanical renovations at the Broad Street Pumping Station including replacement of pumps, furnishing and installation of all internal force main headers and valves, and other necessary work to complete the project. A **mandatory** bidder's conference will be held on Friday, April 8, 2011 at 10:00 am at the project site, located at 200 Broad Street, Bristol, CT 06010. Bids will not be considered from contractors who were not present at said meeting.

Bids will be accepted until **Tuesday, April 19, 2011 at 3:00 pm**, at which time bids will be opened and read. Bids received after the opening date and time will not be considered for award. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bid, to reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid that in its judgment is in its best interest.

Each bid shall be in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Bristol Purchasing Department, identified as "Bid 2C11-084 Mechanical Renovations at the Broad Street Pumping Station" accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the bidders base bid amount, in the form of a Bid Bond made payable to the City of Bristol.

The awarded contractor will be required to secure a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract award, provided by a surety licensed to do business in the State of Connecticut. The requirements for prevailing wage rates as outlined in Connecticut General Statutes 31-53 are to apply to the resultant contract award.
