A non-mandatory bidder's conference will be held on **Wednesday May 25, 2011 at 10:00 am** in Room 100 ("Art Room") at the Beals Senior Community center, 240 Stafford Avenue, Bristol CT.

Bids will be accepted until **Thursday, June 2, 2011 at 11:00 am**, at which time bids will be opened and read. Bids received after the opening date and time will not be considered for award. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bid, to reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid that in its judgment is in its best interest.

Each bid shall be in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Bristol Purchasing Department, identified as "Bid 2C11-094 Installation of Emergency Generator at Beals Senior Community Center" accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the bidders base bid amount, in the form of a Bid Bond made payable to the City of Bristol.

The awarded contractor will be required to secure a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract award, provided by a surety licensed to do business in the State of Connecticut. The requirements for prevailing wage rates are to apply to the resultant contract award.
